- Collaborate with Training Director to build an inclusive campus where all departments interact, celebrate, and train together as one team. Implement strategic initiatives.
- Work with the development team to represent the program through interviews, tours, special events, demonstrations, and presentations.
- Schedule activities to achieve program objectives.
- Oversee and maintain Salesforce, Dropbox and hard copies of dog files.
- Design and prepare reports and analysis on program results and stats.
- Provide input and make recommendations to the Training Director for improvement to program operations.
- Ability to work occasional weekends and evenings as required for special events.

# **ASSISTANCE DOG PROGRAM DUTIES**

- **Puppies:** 
  - Work with current breeder network and help to expand it.
  - Oversee and/or conduct Puppy Temperament Tests (PTT).
  - Schedule veterinary appointments and ensure that vaccinations and health screenings are done on a timely basis.
  - Ensure monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventatives are given to each of the dogs in training. Keep this information updated on the calendar.
  - Oversee the feeding, care and management of all dogs and puppies in training. Keep an updated feeding chart at each campus.

# • **Puppy Raisers:**

- Help recruit new puppy raisers.
- Provide ongoing coaching and counseling.
- Oversee the collection and evaluation of monthly progress reports and correspondences.
- Conduct weekly Puppy Raiser classes and monthly field trips.

# • **Dogs in Training**:

- Oversee the feeding, care and management of dogs in training.
- Evaluate canine temperament and behavior.
- Provide accurate verbal and written reports on training progress.
- Schedule vet appointments and ensure that vaccinations and health screenings are completed on a timely basis.



- Ensure monthly heartworm and flea/tick preventatives are given to each of the dogs in training. Keep this information updated on the calendar.
- Ensure highest standards are met using force-free, science-based, positive training methods during all stages of training.

#### • Internship Program:

- Train and assist interns on campus.
- Ensure that dogs in training are making adequate progress and meet agency standards for assistance dogs.
- Mentor interns in learning proper methods for training dogs and the correct procedures for documenting dogs' progress in training reports.

# • Assistance Dog Applicants:

- Ensure applicants receive timely and accurate information and application materials.
- Assist with applicant interviews and visits.
- Monitor regional waiting lists.
- Collaborate with Application Committee in the matching process for applicants.

# • Clients:

- Oversee Team Training Camp and provide guidance for interns.
- Using the Team Training curriculum, ensure students are taught the concepts and skills required to work with assistance dogs and that quality student instruction is provided.
- Provide lectures, hands-on demonstrations and necessary feedback to students and graduates to allow them to successfully handle assistance dogs.
- Oversee or conduct on-going support and follow-up visits in person or virtually.
- Support graduate teams as dogs are retired.

# **ADDITIONAL DUTIES**

- Participate in at least 20 hours of continuing education courses every two years.
- Participate in Risk Management Program and ensure policies are followed.
- Ensure Volunteer, Client and Dog Records are kept up to date on Salesforce and Dropbox.
- Maintain adequate inventory of training supplies.
- Ensure maintenance of training equipment including wheelchairs, etc.



- Assist with ADI accreditation process.
- Work with team members to plan and schedule specialty classes (Therapy Dog Team class, summer camps, etc).
